

Sinbad, the ship's mascot, was the most publicized individual aboard the CAMPBELL during World War II. Sinbad was listed in the official records of the U. S. Coast Guard as "Dog First Class". Reporting aboard in 1937, Sinbad rode through storms, hurricanes and the early days of almost human antics. During the action described above a crew member asking about Sinbad's safety was told by the CAMPBELL's Commanding Officer, Captain HIRSCHFELD "Nothing will happen to the CAMPBELL as long as Sinbad is aboard her."
