

# COMMANDING OFFICER C.B. NEWLIN, CAPT. USCGC



Captain Newlin, a native North Carolinian, is a 1964 graduate of the University of North Carolina. After graduation he worked as an export controller for General Motors Overseas Operations for two years, and then attended Coast Guard OCS, graduating in June 1966. His first tour was as a Deck Watch Officer aboard the high endurance weather cutter **CHINOTEAGUE** sailing out of Norfolk, Virginia followed by an assignment as an OCS instructor at Yorktown, VA. Back to sea as Executive Officer of the Cutter **MALLOW** in Guam, he worked navigational aids in remote islands of the Pacific Ocean. He then was transferred to New Orleans, LA where he was aide to the Eighth Coast Guard District Commander, followed by his first command, the cutter **SWEETGUM** in Mayport, Florida. After a tour in aides to navigation in Coast Guard Headquarters, he commanded the veteran 311 foot Cutter **UNIMAK** from New Bedford, MA,
