JUNEAU, Alaska (AP)—
The helpless Coast Guard
Cutter Jarvis was towed to
an area of relative safety in
Alaska's stormy
chain Thursday by a Japa-
nese trawler which officials
say kept the craft from being
beached.
The 378-foot Jarvis, engine
rooms flooded and showing
damage "fore and aft," was
towed to the Sedanka Island
inlet after a 9-hour ordeal.
A Coast Guard spokesman
said only the arrival of the
Koyo Maru No. 3, a 338-foot
craft, prevented the Jarvis
from being
