

SANGLEY POINT



LAT. 14° 29' N LONG. 120° 55' E

In Manila Bay the KUKUI tied up at Sangley Point Naval Air Station also home of Coast Guard Commander Philippine Section. Most of the cargo off loaded here was stuff that would be further transported to other Loran stations in the Philippines; stations that the KUKUI would not visit this time. About six tons of clothes and books were off loaded for the Catholic Missions in the Pacific. Since we tied up to a pier and our only job was to off load onto the pier the entire operation took only six hours. On 3 July 1970 the KUKUI set sail for Keelung Taiwan.
