



*The Queen Mary has had a long and unusual history. From the date she was launched in Sep 26, 1934 to where she now rests in Long Beach as a Hotel and Maritime Museum. During her life she has seen many things including war service during WW II, where she served as a troop transport from Mar 1940 to Sep 1946. The Queen Mary was powered by 4 steam turbines that put out 40,000 HP, which gave her a cruising speed of 28.5 knots. She had a length of 1,019.5 Ft and could carry 1,957 passengers. It required 1,174 officers and crew to run her.*
