



PALMER STATION

Palmer Station on Anvers Island is operated for the National Science Foundation by ITT/Antarctic Services Inc. The science activities conducted are in the area of Marine biology, Ornithology, and VLF Radioscience. Located in the warmer climates of the Antarctic the temperature at Palmer ranges from -5 f. to 45 f. The abundance of wildlife in the area including Fur, Leopard, and Elephant seals. Birds like Skuas, Giant Petrels, and Antarctic Terns. An occasional Emperor penguin and a large Adelie penguin rookery make Palmer Station an ideal scientific location.
