

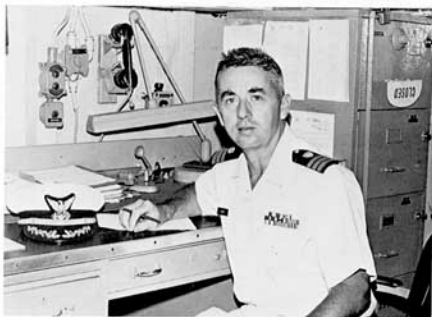
# EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP

## EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Commander Arthur Gove was born and raised in Brooklyn, New York. After graduating from the New York State Maritime Academy in 1944, he served the remainder of World War II in wartime convoys in the Atlantic and Pacific as a Merchant Marine officer. At the end of the war he remained in the Merchant Marine until 1957, attaining an unlimited Master's license.

Upon entering the Coast Guard in 1957, Commander Gove served aboard the Rockaway as Operations Officer followed by tours in Marine Inspection at New York and Saint Ignace, Michigan, where he was Officer in Charge.

## ENGINEERING OFFICER
