Installation

Installation Overview

Welcome to Southern California and Marine Corps Base Camp Joseph H. Pendleton, the site of the Corps' largest amphibious assault training facility, encompassing 17 miles of prime coastline and 125,000 acres.

As the most complete West Coast training facility, Camp Pendleton is one of the Department of Defense's busiest installations. While many military bases share one or more of Camp Pendleton's features, none can match Pendleton's broad spectrum.

The base is home of the I Marine Expeditionary Force, the 1st Marine Division, the 1st Force Service Support Group and many tenant units, including elements of 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing and the Marine Corps Tactical Systems Support Activity (MCTSSA).

Pendleton Marines are environmentally conscientious as they share the land with nearly 400 species of mammals and birds. The protection of several endangered species is considered when planning for training. Camp Pendleton is also home to about 55 bison.

A wide variety of recreational facilities and activities are available on base. Combine these with an unlimited number of local points of interest, to make your tour a pleasant and memorable one.

Use this guide to become familiar with Camp Pendleton and its surrounding areas, and help make the transition of settling into your new home and job easier.

Pendleton has a population of approximately 37,000 active duty Marines and Sailors, with 27% of family members living on base and 73% living off base.

History

On March 10, 1942, the Navy Department announced the purchase of approximately 130,000 acres, the "Rancho Margarita y Las Flores", located between Los Angeles and San Diego. Following the purchase of the vast rancho, the new West Coast Marine Corps Base would be named Camp Joseph H. Pendleton, in honor of MGen. Joseph Henry Pendleton. Camp Pendleton was declared a "permanent" installation in October 1944 and in 1946 General Vandegrift stated that the base's future role was to be the center of all West Coast Marine activities and the home of the 1st Marine Division, the peacetime strength of which would be 12,500. The Corps broadened its mission capabilities since the 1980's, as "amphibious" became "expeditionary", combining infantry, armor, supply and air power. Over the years, Camp Pendleton has demonstrated its successful training and effectiveness in the United States Marine Corps through WWII, Korea, Vietnam, the Persian Gulf, and humanitarian efforts in Somalia and Haiti.

Westwind Express (47 passenger motor coach): (858) 693-6828. From Airport, pick up is at the USO (West Terminal). \$15.00 one way to anywhere aboard the base. Each additional person is 1/2 price within the same family. Children under 3 yrs old are free. Reservations are required for clients leaving Camp Pendleton and Sato Travel on base sells tickets; 5 shuttles per day, 7 days per week to Camp Pendleton. Cash or travelers checks accepted only.

Amtrak Rail: 1-800-872-7245 (Recording) Take local bus to Amtrak Station. \$10.00 one way - to or from Oceanside, \$20.00 roundtrip (including military discount).

United Service Organization (USO) is located in Terminal #2 of the San Diego Airport and is open from 0900-2300, 365 days a year. The USO is a non-profit, civilian operated organization with tremendous support and operates worldwide in more than 160 locations. The facility boasts of a television lounge and sitting area, video games, movies, transportation assistance (referral to shuttle services to Camp Pendleton), and directions as well as free coffee and refreshments. Greyhound Bus Lines: From Oceanside bus terminal to Los Angeles, purchase regular one way ticket, \$11.00, round trip ticket is \$18.00. There is a 15% cancellation fee. Greyhound does not go directly to the airport from Oceanside. For Greyhound schedule call (760) 722-1587. (Recording) To talk to a Greyhound representative call 1-800-231-2222.

Express Shuttle: From Los Angeles International Airport to the Greyhound Bus terminal in downtown LA. Tickets may be purchased from the Greyhound Bus terminal at approx. \$10.00.

Marine Liaison: Offers information to servicemembers who are departing for or returning from overseas duty stations; located in Terminal #2 (lower level, office #1018A). For information or

United Service Organization (USO): Offers information and referral services to active duty personnel, their family members and retirees. METROLINK:

Oceanside is quickly becoming the area's major rail transportation hub. Commuter rail service connecting Oceanside's Transit Center with Los Angeles Union Station via METROLINK is now available. There are currently 8 stops between Oceanside and Los Angeles Union Station. METROLINK currently operates 7am to 6pm, Monday-Friday only. Oceanside Metrolink is located at: 235 So. Tremont Ave., off Mission Avenue. Metrolink has four departures (three in a.m. and one in p.m.) and four return trains to Oceanside (one in a.m. and three in p.m.). One-way ticket \$9.75; round trip \$18.75. For more information about METROLINK call (310) 808-5465.

ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN REQUIREMENTS: All personnel are required to report to the Joint Reception Center (JRC), Building 130132, in service "A" uniform. The duty desk is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. See RELOCATION SERVICES/PCS REPORTING PROCEDURES in this guide book. LODGING: All personnel checking into Camp Pendleton are advised to make reservations for Temporary Lodging and/or Billeting up to 1 year in advance due to the large number of personnel incoming to and outgoing from Camp Pendleton. The summer months are extremely busy for PCS moves, so PLAN AHEAD! See RELOCATION SERVICES/BILLETING in this guide book for phone numbers and details regarding temporary lodging facilities.

CHILD CARE INFORMATION: See category CHILD AND TEEN SERVICES, related subjects Child Development Programs on and off the installation. Please note our "Home Alone" policy. Base Housing regulations for family housing occupants state that children under the age of 12 may not be left home alone in quarters. However, children over 12 years of age may be left alone in quarters and may care for younger children. The guidelines for families with children residing within the local community (off base) are very similar.

There is an informal policy recommending the "home alone" age to be 12-14 to be based on each particular situation and to be reviewed on an individual basis.

RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Relocation Assistance Program of Community Support Services is located in Bldg 13150. Relocation Assistance provides Welcome Aboard Packages, maps and numerous other resources regarding Women, Infants and Children (WIC), child care, education and much more to those who are relocating to Camp Pendleton.

The **WELCOME ABOARD ORIENTATION** is held daily at 0800 and relocation services are provided at the Joint Reception Center, Building 130132. **SPOUSES** are highly encouraged to attend. Please call toll free 1-800-253-1624 extension 5704 or commercial (760) 725-5704 for more information. **HOUSING:** Military personnel with family members reporting to Camp Pendleton for permanent duty are required to report to the Base Housing office, Bldg 1138, before accepting or signing off base housing agreements. See Housing section in this guide book for phone numbers and details.

The SCOUT, Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton newspaper is published every Thursday and distributed to housing and other key locations throughout the base. The SCOUT provides the military community with important military news and useful advertising information. All queries concerning news and editorial content should be

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Legal drinking age is 21 on and off base. Beer, wine and distilled spirits are sold by the package in any type of store or establishment which has an appropriate license. There are strict regulations on base concerning drinking and driving, zero tolerance.

PETS: The California Department of Health Services requires all dogs over four months old to have a certificate of current rabies vaccination stating the type, manufacturer, and lot number of rabies vaccine used and date of administration. All cities and counties in California have dog control ordinances. It is strongly recommended that all cats be rabies immunized. Cats, pet birds and pet rabbits must be healthy on admittance into the state. Parakeets may not be brought into the state for the purpose of sale. Pet ferrets are prohibited in California. Information on base regulations is listed in this guidebook under **RELOCATION SERVICES** section.

PLANTS: Houseplants in potting soil that are kept inside at all times are usually admissible into California. (Except indoors fruit plants.) All houseplants are subject to inspection at the state border for freedom of serious diseases and pests. Outdoor plants are usually not admissible. Some plants are carriers of specific plant diseases and are restricted by plant quarantines. No plants are admissible from Florida, Long Island, N.Y., Hidalgo and Cameron counties in Texas, due to certain infestations. For additional information, contact: California Department of Food and Agriculture, Division of Plant, Health and Pest Prevention Services, 1220 "N" Street, Room A-372, Sacramento, CA 95814, or call (916) 653-1440. Also, all fruits and vegetables are subject to inspection at the state border for freedom of serious diseases and pests. Many fruits and vegetables are restricted/prohibited by plant quarantine. Check with your local State Agricultural Department for current California requirements or call the Arizona State Border.

Vehicles up to four years old are exempt from smog inspection. As of 1 Jan 97, new mandatory Calif. vehicle laws require motorists to show evidence that they have liability insurance to a peace officer if they are stopped for a traffic violation. The second new provision requires motorists to file evidence of liability insurance coverage when they renew their vehicle registration. The law, AB 650, covers autos, motorcycles and commercial vehicles. It does not cover vehicles that will not be operated if the owner is registering under the planned non-operation option.

You must provide original US birth certificate, US passport, or military I.D. and social security number. Drivers license fee is \$15.00. They accept exact cash, money orders or checks drawn on California banks. Vehicle Registration: Must occur within five days of arrival to operate a privately owned motor vehicle on the base. All reporting personnel are required to present orders, identification card,

driver's license, vehicle registration, proof of insurance, and driver improvement card (for age 25 and younger) to enter the base. Vehicles made after 1974 require a smog control device as certified by the State of California; exempt are vehicles up to four years old. The registered owner of the vehicle is responsible for compliance with base regulations pertaining to the registration of the vehicle. However, the person operating the vehicle is responsible for observance of all traffic regulations.

Local Community

Local Community Overview

Oceanside is situated on three miles of sandy beaches and is an ideal mix of an urban and rural environment blessed with almost perfect, year-round weather. Three major freeways, Interstate 5 and Highways 76 and 78, provide easy access to and from Oceanside. The city is also served by Amtrak, which stops in Oceanside, and by Greyhound and Continental Trailways bus lines.

Oceanside's weather, being much like the rest of San Diego, offers the perfect climate for the outdoor enthusiast. Residents have access to numerous golf courses, parks, tennis courts and biking trails as well as facilities for volleyball, basketball and softball. For those who just want to relax, Oceanside Harbor and Harbor Beach are the ideal spots for an afternoon stroll or picnic.

Oceanside has a total of 17 elementary schools, three middle schools, and three high schools, including one continuation school. Health care for the city is provided by Tri-City Hospital located in Oceanside. San Diego County is a natural wonder. Mountains, deserts and beaches sparkle under the mellow sunshine and balmy climate, where the average temperature is a moderate 70 degrees. Covering 4,261 square miles, it borders on the Pacific Ocean with 70 miles of beach and scenic coastline. There are 73 miles of inland waterways. Rugged hills with panoramic views of snow-capped mountains in winter, it is a juncture between the pastels of the desert and the hot primary colors of the tropics.

History

Oceanside's first inhabitants were the Luiseno Indians, part of the large Shoshonean tribe. The Luisenos were hunters and food gatherers until the friars taught them farming and other trades. The Indians were instrumental in building the Mission compound.

Mission San Luis Rey was the largest building in California when completed in 1815, and was the most prosperous of the missions. At its peak, the "King of the Missions" had between two and three thousand Indians living and working in the area. The mission itself covered an area of 6 1/2 acres.

When the petition for the first post office was drawn, the name Ocean Side was used, but later changed to Oceanside. According to local tradition this was a place "that just named itself." Before 1884, it had been the custom for families "to Oceanside" here, their favorite location for beach outings.

On July 3, 1888, Oceanside was incorporated with a vote of 74 to 53. The founder of the city, A. J. Myers, was the first to vote. The population at that time was about 1000.

In 1942, a dramatic change occurred with the purchase of the Santa Margarita y Los Flores Rancho by the US Government, to be used as a military base. The building of Camp Joseph H. Pendleton created a boom to end all booms in the sleepy little town. Workers flocked to downtown for food and lodging. The community geared up for war in a big way by supporting the workers and troops.

Oceanside continued to urbanize into the 1950's, bringing the population in 1953 to 20,000 which is now well over 152,000.

LIFE LONG LEARNING - JOINT EDUCATION CENTER

Classes are offered throughout the installation normally on accelerated term schedules. Advisement and financial aid information is available through the schools. A full-range testing program is available to base personnel and others associated with the base through the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES) Program and College Level Examination Program (CLEP). Tests include credit by examination, ACT, and SAT certification examinations, and more. Independent study courses are offered through catalogs and include more than 100 institutions throughout the United States. Most courses may be applied toward degrees.

An additional program entitled the Military Academic Skills Program is designed to improve learning abilities in the areas of Math, Communications, and English. Students need to see their unit education representative to enroll or call the Joint Education Center. The program is four weeks long during the duty day - 0730-1630. Commanding Officers may refer students or students may refer themselves. They will be on orders to the Joint Education Center. Students completing the program will do better on the ASVAB which helps with lateral moves and they should have better performance back at the unit. The program also helps those interested in pursuing higher education. Note - this program is only available for active duty members.

Another program which has not received much visibility is the Apprenticeship Program. Certain MOS's are approved for the program. Essentially, Marines document work hours with the supervisor and after "X" number of hours, students earn a certificate in their MOS from the Department of Labor and move from the apprenticeship level to journeyman level. This helps when a Marine gets out and wants to work in a trade. Brochures on this program are available. Note - this program is only available to active duty members.

One of the best benefits for active duty members is the Tuition Assistance Program paying 75 percent of the cost of tuition for approved courses towards degrees and certificates. Effective 1 October 1998, every active duty member is entitled to tuition assistance of \$3,500 each year. To register a student, the parents must deliver the child's immunization record, birth certificate, baptismal record, or passport, plus two proofs of

residency/verification of address (such as: driver's license, I.D. card, utility bill, rent receipt, etc., showing name and address), child's Social Security Number, and transcript or previous school address to the school the child will be attending. Call the Base Housing Office for appropriate school. Your child can attend a school on base even if you live off base with you providing transportation to and from school. Contact local school districts for rules and requirements for transferring your children to on base schools. To be eligible for kindergarten, your child must be five years old on or by December 2nd of the present school year.

CENTER BASE PROGRAM: Children attend pre-school 3 1/2 hours per day, four days per week from September to May.

HOME BASE PROGRAM: Children and parents have the opportunity to learn together. The Home Base Teacher comes into the home one time per week for 1 1/2 hours. Children visit the Head Start Classroom two times per month for socialization activities.

HEAD START FAMILY CHILD CARE PROGRAM (FCCP): The program offers a nurturing pre-school program in a home setting. Children attend school for up to 10 hours per day, five days per week, Monday through Friday, from July to June (year-round). FCCP is offered to Oceanside, Vista and San Marcos residents. Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton with 156 beds overlooks Lake O'Neill and is located approximately 10 miles from the Main Gate.

The Naval Hospital participates in the program where TRICARE Prime patients enrolled to NHCP have priority for access to care. Access to care is based upon the following priorities:

1. Active Duty Service Members
2. Family Members of Active Duty enrolled in TRICARE Prime
3. Retirees and their family members enrolled in TRICARE Prime
4. Active Duty family members not enrolled in TRICARE Prime
5. Retirees and their family members not enrolled in TRICARE Prime

Outpatient and inpatient care is provided for all eligible beneficiaries, including active duty, active duty family members, retired persons, their eligible family members and eligible members of deceased military.

For enrollment into TRICARE, patients should contact the TRICARE Service Center located on the 6th floor of Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton, Bldg. H100, or call 1-800-242-6788 (follow the telephone prompts for Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton).

For Health Care advice or educational information on common health care concerns, you may call the Health Care Information Line at 1-800-611-2883.

For those patients who are TRICARE Prime and enrolled to hospital sites: If urgent medical problems arise when your clinic is closed, call the After-hours PCM Urgent Medical Need Line at 1-888-738-7044. A staff physician covering as your PCM is on call; please be prepared to give enrollment, sponsor and social security number information.

Upon arriving at Camp Pendleton, families should bring their medical records to the Outpatient Records Desk located just inside the hospital entrance closest to the outpatient parking lot. This allows entry into the outpatient system and will reduce waiting times during first medical appointments.

All patients are required to show proof of eligibility and must be listed in the Defense Enrollment and Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS). A valid ID Card alone will not guarantee care in non-emergency situations.

Most hospital clinics operate on an appointment basis. Appointments are available by calling the clinic directly, or with a health care provider's referral. Primary Care (Family Medicine, Internal Medicine and Pediatrics Clinic) appointment system is centralized. The telephone number for that service is (760) 725-4327.

**Specialty care not available at Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton is available at Naval Medical Center San Diego, approximately one hour's drive from Camp Pendleton.

The hospital pharmacy is open from 0700-1800 Monday thru Saturday; closed on Sunday. Patients are reminded that waiting times for having prescriptions filled can be lengthy, especially from 10:00 a.m. to noon, and 2 to 4 p.m. The patient ID card is required. Civilian physicians' prescriptions

and those from local naval facilities can be filled from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. only.

AMBULANCE SERVICE

In case of an emergency, ambulance service is available for on base active duty personnel and their family members. Those residing off base should call local paramedics (911). Emergency care is available at the hospital on a 24-hour basis.

TRICARE Outpatient Clinic (TOC)

A TRICARE Outpatient Clinic provides services to all eligible beneficiaries with the same priorities of care as the base hospital, excluding active duty. TRICARE Prime enrollees have priority for care.

State-licensed and credentialed civilian physicians, nurse practitioners and physicians assistants staff the clinics.

TRICARE Outpatient Clinic provides primary general ambulatory care to eligible beneficiaries on an appointment basis. Basic laboratory, X-ray services and medications are provided on site. Services range from providing same day, acute care to management of routine or long-term, uncomplicated, chronic illnesses at NO COST TO THE PATIENT.

Additional services include well childcare, immunizations, women's health screenings, mammography and physical exams for school, daycare or work, health education and family planning.

To be eligible for care, all patients must present a valid military I.D. card and be enrolled in DEERS. Priority for appointments goes to TRICARE Prime enrollees who have selected the TOC as their Primary Care Manager. TRICARE Standard patients will have a very limited access to appointments.

The clinic is open 365 days per year, including weekends and holidays. Hours of operation are Monday-Friday 0700-2000 and weekends/holidays 0700-1600. TRICARE Outpatient Clinic is located at 2122 El Camino Real in Oceanside, one mile North of Highway 78. For an appointment call (760) 966-7500.

The clinic does not provide emergency care. Critically ill or seriously injured patients should go to the nearest military or civilian hospital emergency room.

Active duty personnel may enroll their family members in the Uniformed Services Active Duty Family Member Dental Plan.

The TRICARE - Active Duty Family Member Dental Plan (FMDP) is administered by United Concordia Companies, Inc. in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania. It is a voluntary Comprehensive dental plan available to family members of all active duty Uniformed Services personnel. When the active duty member (sponsor) enrolls family members in the FMDP, a monthly premium is paid through payroll deduction. The plan has cost shares, maximums, and limitations similar to typical civilian dental group plans. The amount covered by the plan ranges from 100 percent to 50 percent, depending on the type of service. Family members must receive dental services in the United States, Canada, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands or Puerto Rico.

Detailed FMDP coverage and enrollment information are contained in the FMDP Benefit Booklet. Sponsors and family members may call United Concordia's toll free Customer Service Department at 1-800-866-8499 (or 1-800-891-1854 for Hearing Impaired) Monday - Friday from 8 AM to 8 PM EST.

Housing

Housing Overview

Nearly 6,200 housing units are available for Camp Pendleton personnel.

Military personnel reporting to Camp Pendleton for permanent duty are required to report to the Base Housing Office at Building 1138 before making a rental or sales commitment in the civilian community.

If Government quarters are not assigned, Housing Referral Services is available for finding off base housing.

Application for assignment to family housing may be made in person or by submitting the Form DD-1746 by mail. Upon receipt of the check-in endorsement and other documents pertinent to each individual family, the application will be activated. Eligibility for assignment begins with a control date which is the date of detachment from the last permanent duty station. Waiting periods range from 3-24 months and may vary according to rank, number of bedrooms, and area requirements. Normally, personnel who wish to live in off-base housing will be permitted to do so. For more information call 725-6246.

Service members enrolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) requesting priority housing are encouraged to contact the Base Housing Office at least 60-90 days before checking into Camp Pendleton. All service members who have been assigned category IV or V based on the needs of their exceptional family member are provided priority housing per MCO 1754.4A. In order to ease their transition and speed up the process of being assigned housing, service members should fax/send the following information to Camp Pendleton Base Housing: written request for Priority Housing, a letter from the medical provider specifying any specific needs, and a copy of detaching/attaching

orders. For more information call Camp Pendleton Base Housing 1-800-843-2182, Fax (DSN) 365-5559.

Please be advised, when moving into Base Housing, it is necessary to fill out a "Lock Change Request" at your local Post Office and pay a \$10.00 (non-refundable) fee to obtain your mail box key. You need to provide your Base Housing Assignment slip as proof of occupancy. The same applies if you lose your key.

The Housing Referral Services office, located at Bldg. 1138, provides up-to-date listings and rates of apartments and private homes for sale or rent.

The Base Housing Office is offering the "Set Aside" program to assist military families on Camp Pendleton eligible for housing in finding an apartment within their housing budget waiving security deposits, credit check fees and first-and-last month rent requirements when searching for housing in the surrounding communities. Agreements have been made with apartment complexes in the local community to set aside apartments for military families. For more specific information, please contact the Central Family Housing Office at (760) 725-5014/6120 or 1-800-843-2182.

Unfurnished apartments in the surrounding cities average \$625 for a one-bedroom unit to \$750 or \$800 for a two-bedroom. Security deposits often equal one month's rent. Individual family home rentals average \$1100-\$1250 per month.

A recent survey has revealed that the average cost of a single-family home in North San Diego County is \$200,000.

Camp Pendleton has one mobile home park located at San Onofre containing 248 spaces that are rented by the Base Housing Office. Occupants must own their own mobile home. For park information call the San Onofre Housing Office at 725-7027/7323.

Relocation Services

Relocation Services Overview

A PCS move can be one of the most exciting and rewarding experiences of your military career: new places, new faces, and new challenges. However, for the servicemember or family who is not prepared, a PCS move can be a very unhappy time. Most of this unhappiness is caused by money problems associated with the PCS move. To help you plan ahead and

keep you in control of your situation, here are some RELOCATION TIPS:

Start saving now. Any PCS move will require additional funds.

Make reservations for TEMPORARY LODGING AT the old and new duty station.

Request a sponsor by filling out a sponsorship request form which you mail to your gaining unit with a copy of your orders attached.

Camp Pendleton does not have Post Office boxes. You can either forward your mail to your new command until you get a permanent address or you can obtain a P.O. box from the Oceanside Post Office (see your local Post Office for details). You fill out an application at your local Post Office which they will forward to the Oceanside Post Office with your check for \$22.00 (for six months) and the Oceanside Post Office will notify you of your P.O. box number and address or you can call 1-800-275-8777. Don't forget to send out change of address cards!

Gather all important papers (to include vital records, school records, medical records) and important phone numbers and keep them handy throughout the move; DO NOT PACK THEM!

Make arrangements with the Traffic Management Office (TMO) for packing and pickup of your household goods.

Check expiration dates on driver's license and ID cards!

Camp Pendleton Child Development Centers prorate payments to the 1st and 15th of the month. Weekly fees for full-time care are based on 10 hours of care per day. A fee will be charged for any and all hours beyond the 10-hour limit. Fees are charged for walking children to and from school. Fees are based on total family income. Income will be verified through the service member's most recent LES. Military income includes Base Pay, Basic Allowance for Subsistence and Basic Allowance for Housing. The spouse's most recent pay stub will be used to verify the income for non-military personnel. Reduced fees for second or subsequent children in families are not authorized. All fees are in effect as of September, 1999. The following are fee ranges established by DoD for school year beginning 1999. Hours of operation are Monday through Friday 0600-1800.

If you are a first term servicemember and reading this SITES booklet, you have just taken the 1st step --- PLANNING!!! The key to any success is to have a plan and a back-up plan. Also, part of the planning process is to have a realistic BUDGET, whether single or married.

Moving presents challenges such as separation from friends, adjustment to a new community and change in your environment.

But relocation also means opportunities to travel and learn through exposure to new and interesting people and places, making new friends and grow professionally by adding to your knowledge, experience and ability to meet new challenges.

CHECK WITH THE COMMUNITY SERVICES' RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TEAM FOR A SCHEDULE OF SMOOTH MOVE WORKSHOPS OR PCS WITH SUCCESS WORKSHOP.

Before You Move

- Start saving now. Any PCS move is going to cost money.

- Get a sponsor. Fill out a sponsorship request form, attach copy of your orders and forward it to your new duty station.

- Contact the Relocation Assistance Program, Community Services, at your current duty station; they have lots of helpful information. Ask for a Standard Installation Topic Exchange Service (SITES) booklet, where more detailed information can be found in the following categories:

Installation	Community	Education
Jobs	Medical/Dental	Housing
Services	Support Services	Relocation

- Find out your new mailing address. Even if it is your new unit or new local post office/post office box, you'll need at least a temporary address.

- Send out change of address cards to credit card companies, magazines, banks, especially anyone who owes you money. Make out a list of companies, addresses, account numbers, etc., so you can have that information readily available.

- Leave a forwarding address with your local post office, as well as with your old unit.

- Gather all important papers and records, keeping them handy throughout the move; DO NOT PACK THEM!

- Talk to your S-1 section. They can calculate approximately how much advance travel pay you rate and talk to you about your allowances, etc.

- Go through your household goods and get rid of all those things you no longer want or need. Have a garage sale.

- Make arrangements with Traffic Management Office (TMO) or Transportation Office for pick-up and pack-out of your household goods.

- Make arrangements for Temporary Lodging at the old and new duty stations. Single servicemembers transient quarters may be available upon check-in to your unit.

- Give a 30 day written notice for vacating your house or apartment, if renting or leasing. Talk with Apartment Manager about clean up. Make sure you have a copy of your pre-inspection checklist (when you moved in). If you own your house, allow plenty of time to sell or rent property.

- Get your family members' school, medical and dental records or arrange for them to be sent to you.

- Ensure driver's license, registration and other valid forms of identification are not due to expire. Also, get the required forms of identification needed.

After You Arrive

- Contact your sponsor.

- Attend the Community Support Services, Relocation Assistance Program's "Welcome Aboard Orientation". Spouses are strongly encouraged to attend.

- Find a local bank or preferably an Armed Forces Credit Union (i.e. Navy Federal or Pentagon Federal Credit Union). Credit Unions charge fewer fees than banks (i.e. minimum deposits, per check etc.). Make sure you check out any financial institution thoroughly.

- Register your vehicle on base. More information to follow in vehicle ownership.

- Call Traffic Management Office or Transportation Office to schedule delivery of household goods.

Reporting Procedures

Vehicle Ownership

Different states have different insurance laws, your insurance company will need to know when and where you are moving. In addition to automobile insurance, attention must be given to driver's licenses and auto registration. To avoid penalties, make sure all autos are properly inspected and registered.

Some specific information for the State of California is listed below:

CALIFORNIA RESIDENT ON ACTIVE DUTY - Must have in possession a current, not expired, CALIFORNIA driver's license.

NON-RESIDENT ON ACTIVE DUTY - You must have in possession either a current, not expired, CA driver's license or a valid driver's license issued by your State of residence.

FAMILY MEMBERS - Family Members must have in their possession a current, not expired, driver's license issued by either CA or their State of residence. If your family member is between 16 and 18 years of age, you must also possess a "Non-Resident Minor's Certificate issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles unless you hold a CA driver's license.

MOTORCYCLES OR MOTOR DRIVEN CYCLES - Both military members and dependents must possess either a Class M CA driver's license or a driver's license from the State of residence. If the latter, the license must be endorsed for motorcycle operation if required by the issuing State. To obtain a Class M CA driver's license, a special written and riding skills test is required.

FORMER DUTY STATION - If you obtained a driver's license in the State of a former duty station (other than CA) it must be replaced with one issued by CA or your State of residence within 10 days of entering CA.

REGISTRATION

Out-of-State registration is valid if the vehicle is currently registered in the owner's State of residence or last duty station.

Out-of-State registration is NOT valid if a military member purchases a vehicle from a non-resident,

unless the vehicle is immediately registered in the purchaser's State of residence or California.

Non-resident Military Registration - Active duty members may register their vehicles in California under this special provision at a reduced fee, provided the member, NOT A DEPENDENT, is listed as the primary owner.

Money Matters

WHERE THE MONEY MIGHT GO

Whenever you make a permanent change of station move, you are going to be faced with some high cost expenses. This list gives some of them. PLAN AHEAD!!!

- Travel costs: Tickets, gasoline, food, lodging, toll, car tune-up, new tires and emergency repairs along the way. Temporary lodging at the old or new duty stations.

- Deposits: Damage and rent deposits on old/new apartments and utilities. Rental of a post office box or opening of a new checking or savings account.

- Insurance for a car, rental or homeowners insurance.

- Food: Re-stocking refrigerator and spice racks.

- Household incidentals: light bulbs, toilet paper, soaps, cleaning supplies and curtains.

OTHER FINANCIAL IMPACTS

- Higher cost of living. This includes not only higher housing and food costs, but things like having to drive farther to work, child care costs, school costs and many others.

- If applicable, lower BAH rates.

- If married, having to live on less money for several months, due to unemployment of spouse.

**WHERE THE MONEY MIGHT
COME FROM**

- Garage Sale before you move.
- Refunds on rent and security deposits from your old home or apartment. It normally takes a couple of weeks to obtain refund.
- Refunds or return deposits from utilities, as applicable.
- Advance base pay, dislocation allowance, and advance travel pay. Some of the identified

allowances may require approval prior to receipt of entitlements. Also, you will have to pay it back. Any questions regarding the advance or relocation entitlements and pay back, check with your administrative section first.

CAUTION: Don't BLOW advanced pay on a car or stereo. Save it for your permanent change of station move.
